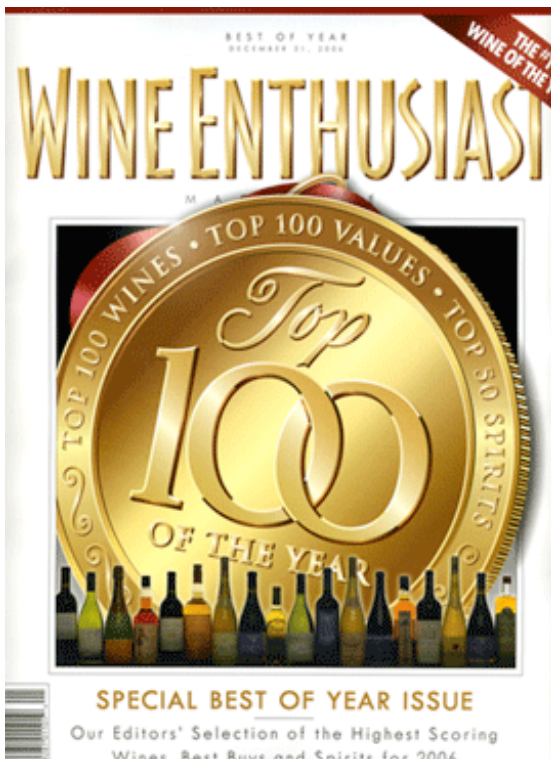


New Reviews from Wine Enthusiast

The December 31st issue of the Wine Enthusiast featured new reviews of Vineyard 7 Cabernet Reserve and Vineyard 8 Chardonnay Reserve. Both wines were selected as Cellar Selections. The reviews are shown below.



2003 Vineyard 8 Chardonnay

"This is a wine to age, or at least to decant. Opened young it shows a hard steely character, even a tannic toughness, that only hints at what's to come. But older examples prove its ageability. This is a Grand Cru Chablis-style Chardonnay of enormous depth and vast potential. Open through 2010, and don't serve it too cold."

2002 Vineyard 7 Cabernet

"This 100% mountain Cab is very, very tannic. Ripe blackberry fruit begins to flatter, and then those tannins rush up like linebackers and shut everything down. This suggest aging. Balanced and dry, it should begin to come into its own by 2008 and develop for many years."
